CCHSM is still a hub of activity! These are <u>some</u> of the events and successes for 2023-2024

- · We received the "Reader's Choice Award" for best museum in Cowley County for the 8th year.
- "Cruise, BBQ and Car Show Too" was held in May at Island Park. 30 cars participated in the cruise along roads in the southeast part of the county. The cruise participants and the public were then invited to enjoy a car show and BBQ.
- "Feed the Need for Speed" held in June had interactive activities for all ages—drones, slot car racing, paper airplane creation and competition, model train, RC racing, timed racing games, food, and more.
- Museum Friends continued to grow. This group offered interesting programs to the public including a Humanities for Kansas speaker. They continued to support and volunteer to help with museum activities and events.
- The new annual exhibit, "Planes, Trains, and Cars of Cowley County", opened in February. It celebrates the rich history of transportation in Cowley County with special exhibits on loan and pictures from the archives. Programs and events throughout the year have celebrated this theme. The exhibit will remain in place through December.
- October was a busy month. The first "Historic Homes Porch Tour" was held. With the help of costumed reenactors, the story of the first families that occupied 6 of the historic homes of Winfield was shared. The "Voices from the Past" Cemetery Tour was also held at the end of October. The stories of some of the early founding fathers for whom streets are named were shared by the costumed reenactors and a walking tour of those gravesites was conducted.
- Our social media presence continued to grow with frequent FACEBOOK posts, and the website was continually updated with additional research links, museum news, a schedule of future events and past newsletters! Check it out!
- Research requests continue to come in from across the country and even the world! The archives continues to grow with wonderful donations throughout the year.
- The Fall Appreciation Gathering was held at Baden Square for Museum Members, Museum friends, and Volunteers. It was an opportunity for all the folks who support the museum in any way to visit and meet each other and to be thanked for all their help through the year. Another gathering is planned for this fall, November 7, at Baden Square.
- Many oral histories were collected. Museum Friends will be using pieces of past oral histories in some of the programs this next year. (Check out the calendar of events included in this packet)
- Special children's events were planned throughout the year. "Bonnets and Ball Caps", an Easter event was held in April. Children created decorated hats and paraded down Main Street accompanied by the Easter Bunny A "Fairytale Tea" for moms, grandmothers, and grandchildren was held in June. A "Polar Express Party" is planned in December.
- The Museum continued to partner with and host several groups through the year—Chamber Coffee, Doc Walk, school field trips, SC Women's Basketball, Winfield Public Library, Marquee, and Master Gardeners to name a few.
- "Celebrate Cowley County History Day" continued to be a popular event. CCHSM has those booklets for sale.
