

Be a part of Cowley County's history!

The Cowley County Historical Society announces the publishing of a second county heritage book. The first was published in 1990, so it's time to record more of our history. The book will consist of family histories as well as the histories of our communities, various organizations, businesses, townships, churches, schools, etc. All county residents and former residents are invited to submit their family's history for this book.

What an amazing opportunity this is for you to honor your family and to forever be remembered as a part of Cowley County's history. You may submit a story about your family, preferably typed, that is no longer than 500 words and one photo for no charge. You may also choose to write several stories for different generations or branches of the family. Five is the maximum number of stories a person can submit.

Basically, *give the country or state from which your family came, the approximate date of their arrival, and the area of the county in which they settled. Tell about such things as education, occupations, traditions, civic involvement, achievements, military service, burial location, and family anecdotes.* Copies of the first book of Cowley County history are available for viewing at the Winfield Public Library and Cowley County Historical Museum. By looking at one of those, you may gain a better idea of what to include. If your family was featured in the first book, then please continue where you left off and update your history. This 9x12 book will contain 300-500 pages, depending on submissions. Inside it will be printed in black on a sturdy white archival paper. The book will be bound in a hard cover that will last far into the future.

This is a huge project for the historical society, so we appreciate your cooperation in submitting stories and photos as soon as possible. We don't want you to be left out!



Community groups

Veterans groups, service groups, nonprofit organizations, volunteer groups, social clubs, churches, schools, businesses, and other organized groups are invited to submit stories about their role in the county. Stories of up to 500 words and one photo will be included free of charge.

Additional story information

Stories can be emailed to the historical society, taken to the museum in person or mailed to the historical society. Count the number of words in your story, and note the total. If longer than 500 words, each additional word will cost five cents. The name of the person writing the story must be included. Remember, you can submit more than one story. For example, you might want to write a story for wife/mother's side of the family and one for the husband/father's side of the family. Check with other members of groups you belong to so that just one submission is made for that group.

Photo information

One 1-column photo will be printed free for each story. You may include additional photos at these prices: \$5 for each additional 1-column photo or \$10 for each 2-column photo. Photos can be scanned (jpeg, 600 dpi) and e-mailed with "CC heritage book" in the subject line. If you take your photos to the museum, we will scan them for you. Do not submit copyrighted photos. If you wish for photos to be returned, you must include a stamped, self-addressed envelope. Choose photos that are clear so they will reproduce well. No matter which way you send photos, identify the person(s), tell briefly about the photo, and tell which story goes with the photo. Also, bring old photos of Cowley County communities and landmarks, and the administrator will happily scan them for the museum's photo files. If possible, they will be included in the history book.

Submission forms

A submission form must be filled out and sent, along with any money owed, before the story and photo can be included in the book. They must be signed! The form is included in this brochure. The deadline for submissions is ~~May 1, 2017~~, but please get them to us much sooner than that if possible.

Index of names **DEADLINE EXTENDED** **AUGUST 1, 2017**

An alphabetized list of individuals mentioned in your story and/or photo must be included. List all names in full as you wish them to appear in the index. Type last name first, then first name, initial and nickname. For example, *Jones, William E. "Bill."* If married, a woman's name should be listed twice: once as *Smith, Mary* and once as *Jones, Mary (Smith)*. If married more than once, her name should appear as many times as her name changed in the story.

Sponsors

To keep the book affordable, the historical society is seeking sponsors to help lower the cost so the books are available to everyone. Names of individuals, businesses, and organizations that donate money will be displayed at the front of the book. There will be levels of donations with a minimum of \$100 to be listed as a sponsor. Donors of larger amounts will also be spotlighted in advertisements, if desired. We hope to place copies of the book in all county libraries and museums. For more information about being a sponsor, call or email the administrator.

Purchasing the book

The book will be for sale for \$55 on a pre-publishing basis. All money will be held in a special account at a local bank. Very few copies will be available later and will cost an additional \$10. Be sure to place your order so you won't miss out. The books would be great gifts for family members, ideal to display in local businesses where customers sometimes have to wait, and a helpful resource for schools and community groups.

Museum information

The Cowley County Historical Society is located at 1011 Mansfield in west Winfield. It is open from 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday except for holidays. Admission is free. Sample Family History

ROY & NADINE ANGLEMYER FAMILY

Roy Anglemyer was born August 26, 1896 in Nowata, Oklahoma. His parents were George and Inez Anglemyer. The family moved to Cowley County when Roy was a child. Roy had two brothers and two sisters.

Pearl Nadine Barnett was born in Cowley County on October 3, 1896. Her parents were Rich and Nancy Barnett. Nadine had one brother and three sisters. Their home was approximately three miles east and two miles north of Winfield.

Roy Anglemyer and Pearl Nadine Barnett were married on May 12, 1918. Also in 1918 Roy served six months in the Army, stationed at Camp Funston, near Ft. Riley, Kansas. The Anglemyers lived several places east of Winfield, including the Barnett home place where Nadine grew up. In 1948 they purchased a farm six miles east and six miles south of Winfield. They lived there until 1961 when they moved to Winfield.

Roy was engaged in farming most of his married life while also working in oil fields, and driving a truck. Nadine was a rural school teacher and continued teaching for a number of years after their marriage. In the early 1950's Nadine became a nurse aide at William Newton Memorial Hospital and continued this for many years, along with special nursing for individual patients.

Roy and Nadine had three sons: Lawrence Lee, born (sometime in) 1933; Arlan Wayne, born April 12, 1936; and Burl George, born November 1, 1937. Lawrence resides in Rose Hill, Kansas with his wife, Sharon, and stepson Heath Balderston. Lawrence has three other children: Jerome, Connie (Wolf), and David; all married with families of their own. Burl is a member of the Kansas Highway Patrol and lives in Dodge City, Kansas. He and his wife Sharon have three children: Chad, Jan (Kaufman), and Tammy. Arlan and his wife Wilma live four miles east of Winfield and have three sons: Keith, Scott, and Jay.

Roy Anglemyer died May 19, 1968. Nadine Anglemyer died July 14, 1979. They are buried at Highland Cemetery in Winfield.
